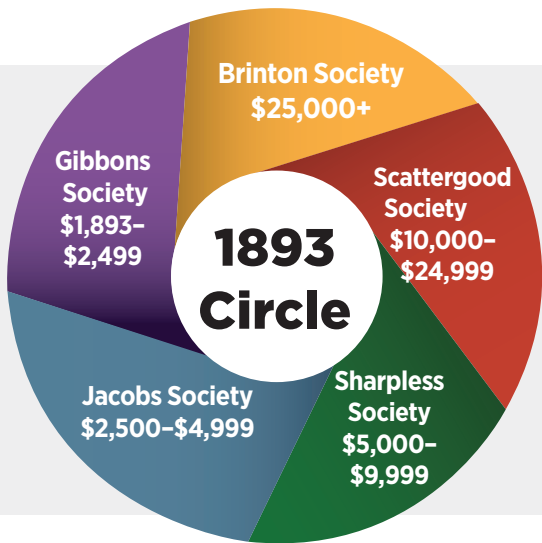

Impact of Giving:

Unrestricted Fund

Unrestricted funds allow Barclay Friends to respond to whatever emergent issue weighs most heavily upon our organization. As you can imagine, unrestricted gifts are so important to Barclay Friends and may be used for overhead costs like expanding staff, equipment, training, and emergency expenses. Your generosity helps us to continue to run smoothly, ensuring the stability of our staff and the residents we serve.



Caring Fund

The Caring Fund helps us uphold a commitment we make to residents and their families that they will continue to receive compassionate care when residents have exhausted their financial means. About 30 percent of residents in skilled nursing care receive Medical Assistance or Medicaid, which does not fully cover the actual cost of care for these residents. Barclay Friends absorbs about \$2 million annually in unreimbursed care.



Horticulture Fund

Barclay Friends enjoys a stellar reputation for the holistic living environment we provide for our residents. Our popular Horticulture Program is one of the key elements of resident life connecting residents to nature and allowing them to enjoy the peace and beauty of nature around them every day of the year.



Staff Appreciation Fund

The Staff Appreciation Fund directly supports our efforts to reward and recognize our dedicated staff who have, in so many cases, worked tirelessly through the pandemic and continue to work to provide the high level of care for which Barclay Friends is known.
